QUIET TIME

10.00pm-7.00am Please help us to ensure all guests have a good night's sleep by keeping noise to a minimum during this time. Music and musical instruments must cease during this time.

PETS

Subject to management approval on arrival. Pets Must be on a lead at all times and not left unattended, no pets are allowed in cabins or any public space. Barking dogs will not be tolerated. (You will be accountable for your dog's actions.) All droppings must be disposed of bags are available around the park. see signage.

CABINS

We ask guests staying in cabins to wash and replace any dishes used, take out rubbish and leave the cabin in a clean and tidy manner. If cabins are not left in a clean and tidy manner additional cleaning charges may apply. cabins are strictly non- smoking.

SAFETY

Please obey the 5 kph speed sign. Parents Must be aware of their children's movements at all times. Be safety conscious. Please stick to the main grassed areas of the park this will minimise the risk of sprained ankles and snake bites, (Yes this is a rural area and snakes are possible).

GENERATORS

The running of generators is prohibited in the park.

CHECK IN/ OUT

Check in time is 2.00pm check out is 10.00am If you wish to extend your stay please enquire at reception. Early check in may be arranged subject to site availability.

FIRES

Fires must be retained in pits provided or in a suitable pit. The responsibility of the fire will be at all time with the occupiers of the site. Fire Pits must be of Sufficient height to stop grass scorching. No fires on total fire ban days. Permission to light a fire pit is required from management.

LAUNDRY

4x\$1.00 coins dryers 3x\$1.00 coins. Laundry open 8.30am-8.30pm. Change can be obtained from office during office hours only. In respect to other park users please leave machines in a clean and tidy manner. Dryer lint filter cleaning is very important.

SMOKE FREE

Smoking is not permitted in any onsite buildings. Please respect the health of others, dispose of butts safely and do not litter. Any evidence of smoking in cabins will incur additional cleaning costs.

DUMP POINT

Please flush then hose away all the contents thoroughly. A large amount of water is required to flush the system as the S bend is very BIG. (Don't worry we have plenty of water.)

VISITORS

Visitors must comply with all park rules. Failure to control your friends and visitors actions may result in your eviction. Visitor parking is out the front of the park. Disabled or elderly people may bring vehicles through after discussion with management and providing there is Sufficient space available.

BOOM GATE

Do not follow other cars through the boom gate. Stop at the card reader and wait for the boom to come down. Then present card to reader and proceed through one car at a time. Caution when the boom is in the up position it will stay up until something passes through between the two poles. If someone walks through this will also trigger the closing sequence. If this happen wait for boom to start coming down, then re swipe card.

DRUGS / ALCOHOL

Any evidence of drug taking will result in immediate eviction and police involvement. Drunken, threatening and aggressive behaviour will not be tolerated either.

BBQ / CAMP KITCHEN

No barbecuing with blinds down. Please clean BBQ after use and turn off gas at valve on bottle. Please don't leave any food scraps lying around and wipe down tables etc, this will minimise ants and mice and will also be appreciated by the next people using the area. 😊 When leaving please turn off lights and close blinds.

BIKE RIDING

Always wear a helmet and ride with caution do not ride between sites and caravans, stick to the main gravelled section. Please observe speed sign and ride sensibly. Noisy children will not be tolerated. Parents will be held accountable for their children's actions and may be asked to leave if they cannot control their children properly.
